

Gregory City Council Special Meeting
August 13, 2007

The Gregory City Council met in special session at the Gregory City Hall on Mon., Aug. 13, 2007 at 6:00 p.m. Members present were: Mayor Doug Pochop; Council Members, Stacey Boes, Gerrie Soper, Dan DeSmet and Kevin Mikkelsen and Wade Juracek. Council Member absent was Maurice Schlaht. Others present were Finance Officer Al Cerny, Public Works Supt. Mark Fortuna and news reporter Colleen Flynn.

PURPOSE OF MEETING:

The meeting was called to discuss the airport hangar, replacing the city loader and use of city water for ball field and park irrigation.

AIRPORT HANGAR:

The council was informed that the asphalt taxi-way is already extended far enough to handle one hangar building. The city would have to extend the driveway from the buildings to the taxi-way. An estimate of \$210,000 was received which would include the 60' x 80' building, erection, concrete work and some heat. Motion was made by Council Member DeSmet, seconded by Council Member Soper, to advertise for bids on a 60' x 80' hangar. All members voted aye.

CITY LOADER:

The council discussed the need for a city loader. One of the loaders is not running and the other one is not big enough to do everything. Bids from Highmore and Winner were looked at. The city can use another city's bid if it is less than 1 year old. Motion was made by Council Member Mikkelsen, seconded by Council Member Boes, to purchase a new loader. All members voted aye.

PARK IRRIGATION:

Mayor Pochop informed the council that the park well is not working. Mayor Pochop would like to drill some new wells on the Wempe Land and then use city water to irrigate the park and ball fields. It was agreed to check on drilling new wells on the Wempe Land and have the park well checked to see what could be done with the sand problem.

AIRPORT VEHICLE:

The council discussed buying a vehicle to move planes. It was agreed that a vehicle that could be used for other things also will be checked into.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT MEETING:

Wade Juracek reported on an economic development meeting that was held on Thurs., August 9, 2007 at the Gregory Fire Hall. The meeting concerned helping pay for school tuition if students would return and work for so many years in Gregory.

ADJOURN:

Motion was made by Council Member Mikkelsen, seconded by Council Member Soper, to adjourn. All members voted aye.
