

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-06

An ordinance amending Sections 90.054 and 90.55 of Chapter 90: Streets and Sidewalks of the ordinances for the City of Gregory.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GREGORY THAT sections 90.054 and 90.055 of Chapter 90: Streets and Sidewalks of the ordinances for the City of Gregory, South Dakota are amended as follows:

90.054 Distances from Curb and Sidewalk

The distance trees may be planted in the City's street right of way shall be 11 feet away from the owner's property lot line towards the street side. If there is a sidewalk present, the tree would be planted 3 feet to the outside of the sidewalk towards the street side. Trees may be planted no closer than 15 feet to the back of the curb in the following Gregory City Additions: Grandview; Hill's Addition; Pleasant view Addition and Duling Addition.

90.055 Distances from Street Corners and Fire Hydrants

No tree planted in the City's street right of way shall be planted closer than 55 feet from the middle of the street right of way width. No tree planted in the City's street right of way shall be planted closer than 10 feet from any fire hydrant.
